IIMA and VIDES welcome the report of the Independent Expert focusing on youth participation and engagement in intergovernmental bodies.

It is indeed crucial for young people to be involved in decision-making processes as well as in the civic space as human rights defenders.

Best practices carried out by IIMA and VIDES young activists in Brazil, India, Philippines and the USA, have proved that youth participation in policymaking are vital in advancing democracy, equality, and human rights.

However, youth continue to face multiple barriers to their effective engagement. Youth formal participation versus substantial, **transformative participation remains critical**. Their participation can constructively change the existing status quo only if their views are truly taken into account where decisions are made.

IIMA and VIDES recommend Member States to:

- 1. Actively engage with and empower youth in decision-making processes so that their perspectives are heard and valued;
- 2. Realize an effective and systematic mainstreaming of youth rights through all the existing UN Human Rights mechanisms, especially the UPR and the Treaty Bodies.
